Motion for Summary Judgment

The Unopposed Motion for Summary Judgment is GRANTED. Defendant has failed a Separate Statement of Undisputed Fact supported by an Order that Requests for Admissions be deemed admitted, that conclusively establish a prima facie case that Defendant is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. While this would normally shift the burden of proof to Plaintiff to provide admissible evidence establishing a triable issue of material, Plaintiff is precluded as a matter of law from disputing Requests for Admissions that have been admitted or deemed admitted. In any case, Plaintiff failed to file a Response to the Separate Statement, failed to file any opposition, and failed to provide any evidence attempting to establish a triable issue of material fact. Accordingly, Plaintiff has failed to meet his burden of proof and the Motion for Summary Judgement is GRANTED. The readiness Conference set for July 18, 2024 and the Jury Trial set for August 20, 2024 are hereby VACATED.

Motion for Defense Costs of \$83,096.31 Pursuant to CCP § 1038.

The unopposed Motion for Defense Costs of \$83,096.31 Pursuant to CCP § 1038. Is GRANTED. Plaintiff has utterly failed to prosecute any aspect of this action or provide any information from which a good faith belief for filing or maintaining the action can be inferred.

Motion for Terminating Sanctions

Defendant's Motion for Terminating Sanctions is DENIED AS MOOT given (1) The fact that Requests For Admission served on Plaintiff have been deemed admitted and therefore conclusive establish that Defendant is entitled to Judgment as a Matter of Law; and (2) The above Order GRANTING Summary Judgment and thereby rendering any issues or evidence that Plaintiff might provide moot.
